



1	<b>Baroosh</b>	Fore Street	McMullen	Popular contemporary town bar with 2 McMullen real ales
2	<b>Blackbirds</b>	Parliament Sq.	Pub Co.	Old coaching inn refurbished in 2016. 3 real ales. Real cider. CAMRA discount
3	<b>Black Horse</b>	West Street	Free House	6 or so real ales + 1 real cider in this 16thC building and enterprising pub. CAMRA discount.
4	<b>Dog and Whistle</b>	Fore Street	McMullen	A new take on an old pub with 2 or 3 McMullen real ales
5	<b>Duncombe Arms</b>	Railway St.	Greene King	Large one-bar town centre pub with 2-2 GK beers + guests.
6	<b>Hertford Club</b>	Bull Plain	Free House	Characterful 15-16 <sup>th</sup> century building – Lombard House. Site of today’s AGM. 3-4 real ales + 1 real cider
7	<b>Lord Haig</b>	Railway St.	McMullen	Refurbished in 2017. A town local with McMullen AK on handpump.
8	<b>Old Barge</b>	The Folly	Free House	Canalside behind the Hertford Club. 4 or more real ales and 3 real ciders
9	<b>Old Cross Tavern</b>	St. Andrew St.	Free House	Beacon for real ale drinkers with own brewery and offering 6 or more real ales including a dark one.
10	<b>Quiet Man</b>	Fore Street	Free House	Newest addition to the town pub scene with 3 real ales. Sport friendly.
11	<b>Salisbury Arms</b>	Fore Street	McMullen	Charming 16 <sup>th</sup> century 3-bar county-town inn and hotel with a full range of Mac’s real ales.
12	<b>Six Templars</b>	The Wash	Wetherspoon	A large mostly modern ‘Spoons with 7 or so real ales. Often has a real cider.
13	<b>White Hart</b>	Salisbury Sq.	McMullen	16thC pub on the square with 3 Mac’s real ales. Refurbished in 2016.
14	<b>White Horse</b>	Castle Street	Fullers	Timeless and small 16thC former beer house with a good range of 4 or so Fullers beers plus 3 others.
15	<b>Woolpack</b>	Millbridge	McMullen	Waterside. McMullen’s “tap” is full of Mac’s paraphernalia on the walls and at the tables. 4 McMullen ales.
